President Cyril Ramaphosa's 7 lockdown promises



1 Those who test positive and cannot self-isolate at home will be isolated at special facilities that have been identified and are now being equipped.



2 Community screening and testing will be rolled out across all provinces, focusing in particular on highly vulnerable communities.

R40 BILLION

3 The Unemployment Insurance Fund has set aside R40 billion to help employees who can't work. To date, it has paid out R356 million.

LET US NOT DISCRIMINATE

4 At all times, we will observe the human rights of all people.

ECONOMIC IMPACT

5 The provision of food parcels has been expanded and spaza shops have received financial support.

WATER

6 To date, government has delivered over 11,000 water storage tanks to communities in need across the country, and many of these have been installed. In addition, 1,000 water tankers have been provided for the delivery of water.

7 Homeless people have been accommodated in 154 shelters across SA.



QUESTIONS

Have SASSA grant payment dates changed?

Has President Ramphosa issued a statement to say all foreign nationals will be deported?

How are lost school days going to be made up?

ANSWERS

Due to the long queues and delays experienced, as from the month of May 2020 disability and Older Persons Grants will be paid from the 4th day of the month. All other grants will be paid from the 6th of every month.

No, this is false. The President has not issued such a statement.

To compensate for lost days the government has recommended that June holidays will be cut short by a week. Schools will be encouraged to extend tuition hours.
